6) FILL IN THE STUDENT TRANSCRIPT (STS) FORM

To be considered for admission to university/college programs grade 12 students must submit their online Post Secondary Choices form by *March 1st for early admission* and *May 1st for regular admission*. This gives your permission to BC's Ministry of Education to release your marks to the post-secondary institutions to which you have applied. http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca and follow the instructions found there. Register for a BCeID (a BC Government account that provides you with access to B.C. Government online services) 1)Register for the Student Transcript Service using your BCeID 2)Log in to your Student Transcripts Service using your BCeID. 3)Follow the steps in order to have transcripts sent electronically to post-secondary institutions.
