## 5) **WRITE THE REQUIRED ENTRANCE TESTS IF NECESSARY**

- Post-secondary English Assessments if required

- TOEFL or IELTS(for ELL students who have been in Canada for a short period of time)

-SAT or ACT (for study in the USA) – do in grade 11 to get results in time for university applications

## 6) **FILL IN THE STUDENT TRANSCRIPT (STS) FORM**

To be considered for admission to university/college programs grade 12 students must submit their online Post Secondary Choices form by **March 1st for early admission** and **May 1st for regular admission**.

This gives your permission to BC's Ministry of Education to release your marks to the post-secondary institutions to which you have applied. <http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca> and follow the instructions found there.

**Register for a BCeID** (a BC Government account that provides you with access to B.C.

Government online services) **1)Register for the Student Transcript Service** using your BCeID **2)Log in** to your Student Transcripts Service using your BCeID. **3)Follow the steps in order to have transcripts sent electronically to post-secondary institutions.**

## 7) **APPLY FOR STUDENT LOAN IF NEEDED**
