# International Day for the Elimination of Violence Against Women- November 25<sup>th</sup> Since 2008, the UN Secretary-General and UN

Since 2008, the UN Secretary-General and UN Women have been spearheading a global initiative with the goal of preventing and eradicating violence against women and girls. This effort calls for worldwide engagement to raise awareness, advocate for change, and encourage open discussions about the challenges and solutions surrounding this issue.

#### Why we must eliminate violence against women.

Violence against women and girls (VAWG) stands as one of the most pervasive, enduring, and severe violations of human rights in our contemporary world, often going unreported because of the prevailing culture of impunity, silence, stigma, and shame. While gender-based violence can affect individuals of any background and in any location, certain groups of women and girls face heightened vulnerability. These groups include young girls and older women, women who identify as lesbian, bisexual, transgender, or intersex, migrants and refugees, indigenous women, ethnic minorities, women and girls living with HIV and disabilities, and those enduring humanitarian crises.
