



## Take Introduction to Health Science 1115 this summer! (Richmond SD38 Dual Credit)

**Are you interested in taking a degree in Health Science or Nursing?  
If so, get ahead by taking this tuition-free dual credit course!**

SD38 students entering Grades 11 or 12 this fall are invited to apply to **take Intro to Health Science (HSCI 1115) at the KPU Richmond Campus this summer**. This course supports a KPU degree in Health Science or Nursing and is university transferable. **TUITION is paid** by Richmond SD38. Successful students earn dual credits: KPU credits (3) plus one Grade 12 course (4 credits toward high school graduation). Students may be required to purchase a course textbook. Course schedule and description are outlined below. International students may be considered if the class is not full.
