Graduation Numeracy Assessment Grades 10 (April 16-18)

The GRADUATION NUMERACY ASSESSMENT 10 (GLA 10) will be held this week at Palmer Secondary School between Tuesday, April 16th to Thursday, April 18th, **beginning promptly at 8:30am**. All current Grade 10 students (and any grade 11-12 students who have not written the GLA 10) are registered to write the GLA 10. The provincial assessment will be administered in rooms 114, 116 and 141. Student room assignments are posted outside the school's office.

Grad Assessment Instructions:

- Arrive early - be sure to arrive by 8:15 as assessments start promptly at 8:30am.
- Bring your student photo ID, your PEN (personal education number), a pencil (NO PENS allowed), eraser, and a water bottle. Calculators are allowed and are also available within the assessment.
- All Cell phones and devices must be stored turned OFF in your bag/backpack, and bags/backpacks will be stored at the front of the room.

Please note: The Graduation Numeracy Assessment 10 will be run using **THREE extended PLT sessions** on Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday.

On each of the grad assessment days, we will start the day with the Grad Assessment and PLT, followed by two 35 minute and two 40 minute classes. Please see the schedule below.

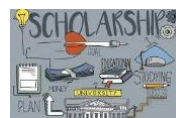
Grad Events – Payments coming due
