### 3) ATTEND THE POST-SECONDARY INFORMATION SESSIONS

College and University in-school presentations (library) and also the post-secondary open houses in person and online throughout the year.

- Remember our school's BC Post Secondary Information Fair (PSI Day) in November as well as the Canadian University Event (CUE) in Surrey and Burnaby in Early October.

#### 4) WRITE THE REQUIRED ENTRANCE TESTS IF NECESSARY

-Confirm you have the prerequisites for the programs you're applying for.

- TOEFL or EILTS (for ELL students who have been in Canada for a short period of time)

-SAT or ACT (for study in the USA) - do in grade 11 to get results in time for university applications

## 6) FILL IN THE STUDENT TRANSCRIPT (STS) FORM

To be considered for admission to university/college programs grade 12 students must submit their online Post Secondary Choices form by **March 1st** – but do it in the Fall and it's done! This gives your permission to BC's Ministry of Education to release your marks to the post-secondary institutions to which you have applied. <u>http://www.StudentTranscripts.gov.bc.ca</u> and follow the instructions found there.

**Register for a BCeID** if you do not yet have an account.(a BC Government account that provides you with access to B.C. Government online services)

1)Register for the Student Transcript Service using your BCeID number.

**2)Log in** to your Student Transcripts Service account, and select the schools you are considering applying to.

**3)Follow the steps** in order to have transcripts sent electronically to post-secondary institutions.

#### 7) APPLY FOR STUDENT LOAN IF NEEDED

Apply in June. See <u>www.StudentAidBC.ca</u>
