Course Selection FAQs

Do I have to take Social Studies 11 to take grade 12 social studies courses? No. The only pre-requisite for grade 12 social studies courses is Social Studies 10.

Is there a pre-requisite for _____?

For pre-requisites, please refer to the Palmer website. If a pre-requisite is required, it will be indicated in the course description. See example below.

SS: LAW 12

Prerequisite: Social Studies 10

This course is an overview of the legal system in Canada. Students will explore how law promotes citizen to participate in society using legal rights and responsibilities. Students will also consider how law can both initiate social change and preserve existing social norms. Topics discussed include the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, human rights codes, as well as criminal and civil law systems. During this course students are expected to attend a field trip to the Vancouver Law Courts and to participate in a mock trial.

Can I take two sciences? Can I take three sciences?

Yes. Circle one of the sciences on the list then write the other science(s) as electives. Priority is given to students enrolling in their first science. Other seats will be allocated based on availability.

If I choose Incentive/CLE Leadership/Peer Tutoring/Leadership/IDS/AP does that mean I automatically get in?

No, all student applications will be reviewed before final decisions are made by staff. You will know your status by May.

You can choose a course at the next grade level or an elective.

I wrote that I want to take ______ with RVS or another online provider next year. How do I choose that on myEd?

You cannot choose other schools' courses on myEd. If you want to take a class online, you must still maintain a full-time schedule at Palmer (8 classes, or 7 if you are in grade 12).
