

### HOME ECONOMICS/TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION

- HOME EC/TECH ED: THIS COURSE IS DIVIDED INTO TWO HALVES: TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION AND HOME ECONOMICS.
- AS AN EXPLORATORY COURSE, IT INTRODUCES THE HOME ECONOMICS AND TECHNOLOGY EDUCATION WORKSHOPS AT PALMER.
- IN TECH ED, YOU WILL LEARN THE SAFE OPERATION OF BOTH HAND AND POWER MACHINERY. FOCUS IS ON EXPERIMENTATION AND DEVELOPMENT OF SKILLS.
- YOU WILL BE INTRODUCED TO THE VARIOUS AREAS OF HOME EC, NAMELY TEXTILES AND COOKING.

### ELECTIVE OPTION 1: ART/DRAMA

#### **ART: GENERAL 8 – No Prerequisite**

This course provides a foundation for a basic understanding of art. Students will learn to produce and respond to works of art in many different art media, including drawing, painting, printmaking, ceramics sculpture and mixed media. Students will be expected to keep a visual journal as a record of their ideas, image development and explorations. This course is paired with Drama 8.

#### TH: DRAMA 8 No Prerequisite

This course is an introduction to creative drama. Students will explore the foundational skills of voice, movement, tableaux, pantomime, improvisation, and storytelling. Students will learn the basics of script reading, scene studies and character analysis. Students will develop their acting skills as well as their imaginations. No previous experience is necessary. This is course is paired with Art 8.





**ELECTIVE OPTION 2: MUSIC** 

#### **INSTRUMENTAL MUSIC: CONCERT BAND 8**

No Prerequisite: Elementary Band experience recommended but not required.

This course is open to all grade 8 students who want to learn and continue to develop musical skills for playing a band instrument in an ensemble. Students will play a variety of musical styles and perform in several performances during the year. Regular home practice and attendance at concerts and rehearsals are necessary for success in this course.
