

# How to Complete your Course Selection on MyEd


\*The best device to use to select your courses is a **computer**. If you use a mobile device, you may not be able to see all the courses that are offered.

## Step 1

Go to <https://myeducation.gov.bc.ca/aspden/logon.do> and log in.


\*If this is the first time you are logging in, refer to your course selection sheet for your username and password.

2. Students may select either

- Math 9/10 Honours\*\*

3. Students must choose 3 electives. Write alternates on your Program Planning sheet AND enter them into MyEd.

Students are required to have a **complete timetable of 8 courses.**

You must return your signed Program Planning sheet to your counsellor by February 9, 2024. This is also the last day to input requests on your account. If you need a course that is not listed, please comment in "Counsellor Notes".

\*\*Students who wish to enrol in the Incentive Program must complete an application.

ELL students: Please refer to your Program Planning sheet for your required ELL classes.

### Step 4

Under "**Primary requests**", click on "select" to select your **8 required courses**, including your first-choice electives. Do not include your alternate electives.

## Course Selection FAQs

**Do I have to take Social Studies 11 to take grade 12 social studies courses?**

No. The only pre-requisite for grade 12 social studies courses is Social Studies 10.

**Is there a pre-requisite for \_\_\_\_\_?**

For pre-requisites, please refer to the Palmer website. If a pre-requisite is required, it will be indicated in the course description. See example below.

**SS: LAW 12**

**Prerequisite: Social Studies 10**

This course is an overview of the legal system in Canada. Students will explore how law promotes citizen to participate in society using legal rights and responsibilities. Students will also consider how law can both initiate social change and preserve existing social norms. Topics discussed include the Canadian Charter of Rights and Freedoms, human rights codes, as well as criminal and civil law systems. During this course students are expected to attend a field trip to the Vancouver Law Courts and to participate in a mock trial.

**Can I take two sciences? Can I take three sciences?**

Yes. Circle one of the sciences on the list then write the other science(s) as electives. Priority is given to students enrolling in their first science. Other seats will be allocated based on availability.

**If I choose Incentive/CLE Leadership/Peer Tutoring/Leadership/IDS/AP does that mean I automatically get in?**

No, all student applications will be reviewed before final decisions are made by staff. You will know your status by May.

**Where do I submit application forms for CLE Leadership/Peer Tutoring/Leadership/IDS/AP?**

**How do I take an Incentive class if I'm not already in the program?**

**If I can't get into a summer class in June, what should I do?**

Tell your counsellor so they can change your schedule.

**If I take \_\_\_\_\_ in the summer, what should I take for next year?**

You can choose a course at the next grade level or an elective.

**I wrote that I want to take \_\_\_\_\_ with RVS or another online provider next year. How do I choose that on myEd?**

You cannot choose other schools' courses on myEd. If you want to take a class online, you must still maintain a full-time schedule at Palmer (8 classes, or 7 if you are in grade 12).
