- 1. Meet and greet / Attendance.
  - Five people attended and were welcomed by the Principal and the PAC secretary (in the absence of the PAC chair)
- 2. Approval of the previous minutes and adoption of the meeting agenda.
- 3. School update from the administration, Mr. Ghaug:
  - Report cards were sent on Feb 6<sup>th</sup>, any families having trouble accessing these should contact the school office for a printed copy
  - Semester 2 interim reports will be shared on Feb 25<sup>th</sup>, where teachers will raise any challenges or concerns
  - Course selection sheets due on 13<sup>th</sup> Feb, the courses selected by students will be used to ensure appropriate resourcing for courses to run next year
  - The number of students at Palmer continues to grow year on year. It is likely that the school will be deemed to be at maximum capacity this year.
  - A reminder to parents to try to avoid peak times to reduce traffic. The school opens at 7.30am and students are welcome to arrive from then onwards
  - The superintendent for schools has shared a strategic plan for 2025-2030. Families are encouraged to access this and provide input (sd38.bc.ca/strategicplan)
