





## HOME ECONOMICS AND TECHNOLOGY ( DEDUCATION Output Description Des



•Teaches students the safe operation of both hand and power tools. Focus is on experimentation and development of simple skills (measuring, marking, cutting) to cook, sew and build.

•Assists in building familiarity with the technology and home economic spaces.



#### FINE ARTS ELECTIVE



Art 8: Helps build knowledge of art including creating and response to different art mediums (drawing, painting, printmaking, ceramics, sculpture and mixed media)

Drama 8: Introduction to creative drama (voice, movement, tableaux, pantomime) Students will develop their imagination along with acting skills.






